ADI Staff Updates

Courts

Indigenous Peoples' Day (Columbus Day) No Longer a Court Holiday

The <u>court holidays</u> changed this year. The court closed for Native American Day (September 23rd) and will remain open on Indigenous Peoples' Day (Columbus Day), October 10th. ADI follows the court's holiday schedule.

Augment Motions in Division One – Criminal Cases

Division One is asking that attorneys submit augment motions *within the first 30 days* after receiving the record in criminal cases, and *prior to* any request for extension of time.

There are unavoidable scenarios where an augment motion will need to be filed after an extension of time. In those circumstances, it's helpful to explain to the court why there was a delay (e.g., counsel sought correction via letter to the superior court, but the request was denied, large record required additional time to complete the review).
