Claims Corner – Electronic Transcripts & Printing Costs

JCC will reimburse the cost of printing an electronic transcript for the client if counsel had no option for a paper copy. If you receive an electronic copy and need a paper copy for the client, contact the superior court clerk to request a paper copy. (ADI has posted relevant information on the SharePoint Site under Practice Resources, General Practice. We've compiled superior court practices and contact information. As we receive new information, we will continue to update this chart.)

If the superior court will not provide a paper copy, then counsel can claim the cost of printing a copy for the client on **Line 10 of Expenses**. Note on the claim that the superior court provided an electronic copy and would not provide a paper copy when asked.
