ICWA Inquiry Issue & Protective Custody Warrants

The California Supreme Court granted review *In re Ja.O.*, S280572 (E079651; 91 Cal.App.5th 672), and *In re Robert F.*, S279743 (E080073; 91 Cal.App.5th 492). The CSC designated the issue as follows: "Does the duty of a

child welfare agency to inquire of extended family members and others about a child's potential Indian ancestry apply to children who are taken into custody under a protective custody warrant?" *In re Ja. O.* is the lead case.
