Sentencing and Resentencing

SB 73: probation eligibility for drug offenses

SB 81: dismissal of enhancements; prospective only to sentencing after 1/1/2022

AB 177: eliminates more administrative fees

SB 317: competency hearings; custody credits for state hospital

AB 333: PC 186.22 gang benefit more than reputational; bifurcated trial; presumptive middle term as of 1/1/2023

SB 483: Eliminates most 667.5(b) and some drug prior enhancements; imposes CDCR and court deadlines

AB 518: Amends PC 654 to permit court to select which offense to sentence and which to stay

SB 567: Term not to exceed middle without jury findings

SB 775: expands PC 1170.95 to manslaughter, attempted murder

AB 1540: recall and resentencing procedures expanded, moved to PC 1170.03

<u>Other</u>

AB 124: lenience for trauma, trafficking and violence victims and those under 26 years old at the time of offense

AB 292: alters CDCR programming credits

AB 1228: O.R. release for violations

AB 1259: PC 1473.7 applies to all convictions

<u>Juvenile</u>

SB 92: Sets DJJ closure to June 30, 2023

SB 383: expands juvenile DEJ

AB 624: immediate appeal from transfer order
