Notable Legislative Action

The Governor has signed <u>AB 1071</u> to expand the Racial Justice Act and <u>AB 1376</u> to prevent endless probation in juvenile cases by limiting the length of the term of non-custodial probation.

Statewide Policy for Project Office Approval for Expert/Investigator & Translator Expenses

The Administrative Presiding Justices have increased the total amount project offices can approve for investigators, experts, and translator fees. Effective immediately, project offices can approve up to \$1,700 in fees. These amounts will increase in future years as follows: Effective July 1, 2026, Project Offices can approve up to \$1,900 in fees. Effective July 1, 2027 and forward, Project Offices can approve up to \$2,100 in fees.

To obtain pre-approval in the Fourth Appellate District, consult with the assigned staff attorney before incurring any investigator or expert expenses. Pre-approval is not required for translator fees.
