

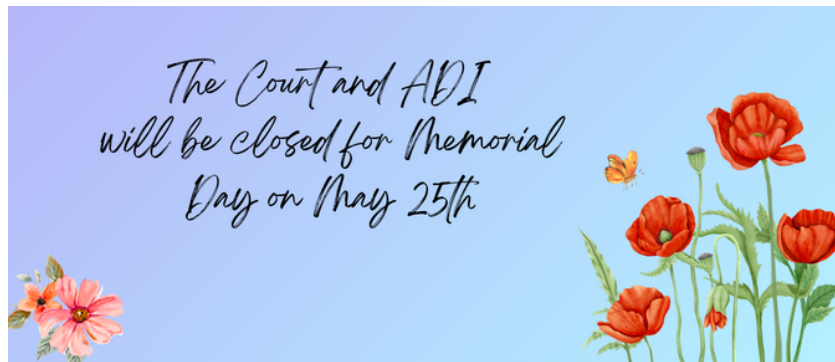

### Extensions of Time (Post-Conviction Appeals) & Oral Argument in Division One

When seeking an extension of time in post-conviction appeals, be sure to include the record length of any underlying trial transcripts that need to be reviewed.

Division One will set oral argument within 6 months after briefing is complete. When requesting oral argument, be ready for a quick turnaround. If you are unavailable, the court will more likely advance the oral argument date. (The court is not inclined to extend the date for oral argument.)
